

# QlikView Server and Publisher (standard)

This course is designed for systems administrators who will be involved with the implementation of QlikView Server and Publisher (standard) in order to deploy QlikView applications.

The course will cover the installation of QlikView Server and how to get the maximum benefit from your underlying hardware platform. Elements of QlikView Publisher (Standard Edition) will also be covered. You will learn how to control how your company's QlikView applications are distributed and how you can automate the data update and distribution process.

## Topics include:

- Clients – Which client will work best and meet different objectives within the organisation. Includes Zero footprint, Active-X plug-in, Java and the locally installed windows client.
- Fast and incremental data load – Time and power saving updates of data achieved through storage in QVD (QlikView data) files
- Security and Access control – Integrating your company's security structure allows you to give users access to analyse permitted data and applications.
- Access to current data and reliable information – Satisfy the company's need to always show only the latest versions of all of your QlikView applications
- The QlikView Publisher concept – including functions, definitions, tasks, user profile etc
- Installation of QlikView Publisher
- Workflow in QlikView Publisher – including distribution, scheduling and automatic updates

A good knowledge of Windows is required together with experience of server administration. Experience of working with Windows security.
